

STUDENT EXCHANGE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
TOKYO CITY UNIVERSITY
JAPAN
AND
DNIPRO UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY
UKRAINE

This agreement defines the study-exchange system based on the Memorandum of Understanding between Tokyo City University (TCU), Japan and Dnipro University of Technology (DUT), Ukraine (hereby referred to as "*the Parties*").

The parties agree to the following:

Responsibilities of Both Parties

1. **INSURANCE:** Exchange students will be required to have all necessary insurances, of a type and amount acceptable to the host institution, the cost of which will be paid by the students.
2. **ACCOMMODATION AND LIVING EXPENSES:** The host institution shall assist students obtaining safe and secure accommodation. It is a responsibility of students to pay for their own housing and living expenses.
3. **TUITION AND FEES:** Exchange students pay tuition fees at their home institution. Tuition, entrance examination and admission fees for exchange students at the host institution are waived.
4. **EXPENSES AND OTHER FEES:** Students shall satisfy the home institution that they have adequate funds for their own expenses including but not limited to transportation, related expenses to and from the host institution during their stay, host institution's fees not related to tuition and expenses obtaining a visa for the country of the host institution.
5. **ENTRY VISA:** Each institution will provide appropriate certificates of eligibility for visas and/or other documentation as required by government agencies in the host country.
6. **STUDENT SELECTION:** Both institutions will strive to designate only well-qualified individuals for participation in the program.
7. **DEPENDENTS:** The obligations of each institution under this agreement are

limited to the exchange students only and do not extend to spouses or dependents. Expenses of accompanying spouses and dependents are the responsibility of the exchange student.

Selection Criteria

Students should follow the required procedure at their home institution. When applying to the exchange program, students will be required to give consent to their application material being forwarded to the selecting faculties at both partner institutions. Applicants will be pre-selected by their faculties on the basis of the written application materials and / or an interview. All necessary information with respect to selected candidates, including academic backgrounds and courses they wish to undertake will be provided to the host institution. The home institution will submit nominations of its candidates for the student exchange program prior to the final nomination date.

Exchange students will be selected by their institution on the basis of the following criteria:

- be citizens, permanent residents or have a valid temporary resident visa of the country of their home university;
- have completed at least one-year of full-time study at their home university;
- have a good to excellent academic record; and
- meet all requirements declared by both parties.

Exchange of Students

1. The period for which the exchange students will be received shall be one (1) or two (2) semesters.
2. Each academic year, each institution will receive up to ten (10) exchange students. Participants under this Agreement will be enrolled as non-degree students.
3. All exchange students must remain enrolled at the home institution for the duration of their exchange. The home and host institution agree to exchange transcripts of subjects, credits and grades of each student. Credits for subjects taken will be transferred at the discretion of the home university.
4. Exchange students must comply with international exchange immigration and other requirements of the host country and with rules and regulations of the host institution.

Period of Agreement

This agreement shall become effective when signed by the appropriate representatives of both parties below and shall remain effective for five (5) years from the last signing date. Any decision to renew the terms of this agreement shall be made on the basis of consultations between the two parties.

The termination of this Agreement prior to the end of the five (5) year period, may come into effect after deliberation by both parties, and after six (6) months' written notice is given by one or both parties to the other.


In the case of early termination of the Agreement, the Parties agree that any previously approved exchange shall continue and be completed as if the Agreement had remained in force.
