AGREEMENT

On Mutual Cooperation on Scientific Research Area between the National Mining University of Ukraine University (Ukraine) and Hacettepe University (Ankara, Turkey)

This agreement is signed to establish an international collaboration between National Mining University of Ukraine and Hacettepe University on mutual academic process and scientific-research fields. The parties have agreed on the following forms of cooperation:

- 1. Training of experts, scientists and educational staff of various scientific research fields in techniques and education methods, through collaboration.
- 2. Holding scientific conferences, seminars and symposiums on current obstacles of higher education. Meetings will target teaching advance methods, for academic staff training.
- 3. Rendering of methodology and information assistance towards international projects, in the fields of higher education.
- 4. Exchange of leading scientists for lecturing on corresponding branches of sciences and special disciplines.
- 5. Development and exchange of curricula, programs and educational textbooks and materials, on general education topics and main subjects of higher education.
- 6. Exchange of students, who successfully completed freshmen year, and organization of scientific training.
- 7. Mutual assistance on organization of industrial practices at corresponding enterprises.
- 8. Cooperation towards the use of the education and scientific equipment, faculties, laboratories and the scientific information, which are in mutual interest.
- 9. Participation in holding festivals, anniversaries and other cultural activities.
- 10. Cooperation between faculties, departments and other divisions of the institutes will be carried out under separate arrangements.
- 11. To fulfill the planned activity under the present agreement, each partner will use their financial resources. Hosting partner should handle the accommodation expenses (except transport) during the visit to the country.
- 12. The agreement is operative from the day it's signed by both parties and will be valid for five years.
- 13. For the cases, which haven't been stipulated in this Agreement, the parties are guided by the legislation of the states.
